



How can I help my child learn to read?

Have your child read aloud to you. A few minutes a day can make a difference. Here's an easy tip to help your child learn:

Select a short book or newspaper article that is interesting to your child. Have them read it to you. Reread it several days in a row to increase accuracy and fluency. If your child misses a word, read it for them the first time. When they reread it check to see if they remember it correctly.
