



How can I help my child learn to read?

Being a good reader takes daily practice. Read with your child whenever you can. Here's an easy tip to help your child learn to read:

Listen to your child read - newspapers, books, road signs - everything. Be patient and remember to give him time to sound the word out. When a child reads even a simple word for the first time, be sure to praise her. Let your child know you are proud of their accomplishments.
